Event Details/Entry Information

- Venue: Event will be held at Teamworks Dog Training in Youngsville, NC, located just East of the Raleigh. The address is 195 Robbins Rd, Youngsville, NC 27596. The website is TeamworksDogTraining.com. The phone number for event information is 919-855-0422.
- Admission: Admission for the general public is free.
- Parking: Special parking for RVs is available for \$10 per night by calling 919-855-0422 to make a reservation.
- Crating: There will be ample grass for kenneling, and pop ups will be allowed.
- Shade: There will be one shaded tent holding area for competitors and one shaded tent for spectators.
- Venue Rules: Please bring leash and kennel for your dog. Dogs are not allowed in the agility rings or on the agility equipment. Please pick up after your dog!!!!
- Event Notes: *This event is only Big Air Jumping*.

Event Rules/Information

- This is an outdoor event to be held at a fully-fenced pond. The pond is spring-fed and has BioBlack, a algae and bacteria preventer, and is 100% safe for dogs to drink. (Some dogs with very sensitive skin may benefit from being hosed off, and a hose will be provided.) The pond also has traction matting along all the edges so that dogs can easily exit the water on all sides of the pond.
- The dock is 40 feet long, with traction-carpet footing and ramps for easy access.
- This event will be open to all dog / handler teams who wish to enter as space permits.
- Please bring crate to kennel your dog. Dogs must be on leash or in a kennel at all times. No off-lead dogs will be permitted.
- Absolutely no shock collars will be allowed on the premises.
- Physical abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. The handler will be excused from competition and no refunds will be given.
- Absolutely NO pushing, shoving or throwing your dog into the pool.
- Please have dogs shots up to date, tags or bring current shot and vaccine papers.

- Please be responsible for the safety of your dog and others!!!
- Dog / handler teams may enter only one or as many Waves as they wish (a separate entry fee must be paid for each wave)
- Dog / handler teams will be placed in groups of up to 15 teams within each heat.
- Each team will receive two (2) competition jumps during the practice jump time only.
- One dog/ handler on the dock at a time during competition. Only one dog off lead at a time.
- All dogs will have the opportunity to acclimate to the dock area prior to their first official competition jump as time permits.
- *Practice time will only be held from 8am-9am each morning*. The dock will closed to all practice jumping 15 minutes prior to the start of the first competition Wave. Please note that the doggie swimming pond at Teamworks is available for rental up until the Friday before the event. Call 919-855-0422 for more information or register online at TeamworksDogTraining.com.
- Show hours are 7am-1pm.
- Please check in at least 1 hour before your wave, as waves may begin sooner if we are ahead of schedule.
- Be ready for your wave. You will be scratched from the heat if you are not available.
- Event Finals will take place on Sunday afternoon. The top 12 dogs overall will meet in the finals on Sunday. The top 6 will qualify for the Pro finals and the next 6 qualify for the Open Finals. Prize money for the top 4 Open, Pro, and Lap Dogs.
- Handlers or handlers representatives must be present to accept ribbons and awards.
- Ribbons will be awarded after each heat, so stick around. Ribbons will not be mailed.
- Female dogs in heat will NOT be allowed on the grounds! Please leave them at home.
